2025 MEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to Male Amateur golfers who are members in good standing of Arrowhead Men's Club, (18 years of age or older) as of August 15, 2026. Any entry without a 2025 USGA Handicap will be eligible for gross prizes only.

RULES: USGA Rules of Golf will govern all play. All questions will be resolved by the Arrowhead Men's Club Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final.

DIVISIONS & TEES:

Championship Division- All ages playing from the Black Tees

(Only division eligible to be Club Champion. OGA Team Championship points qualifier.)

Open Division- All ages playing from the Blue Tees

Senior Division- Players age 50 and over playing from the White Plus Tees

Super-Senior Division- Players age 65 and over playing from the White Tees

FORMAT AND PRIZES: Cumulative Stroke Play, Gross and Net merchandise prizes awarded to top finishers in Open Division, Senior Division, and Super-Senior Division depending on number of entries. **Gross prizes only in Championship Division.**

TIES: In the event of a tie for the Gross Championship in any division, the winner shall be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off. All other ties will be split.

PROHIBITION OF OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Electronic devices can only be used for matters relating to the tournament (live scoring, rules questions) and for emergencies. **Earbuds and music are also prohibited during play.** Any violation of this rule will be followed by a verbal warning. A second violation and any thereafter will result in a penalty at the discretion of the tournament committee.

GOLF EQUIPMENT: (14 Club Limit) The penalty for making a stroke with a non-conforming golf club is DISQUALIFICATION. The so-called "One Ball Rule" SHALL NOT BE IN EFFECT!!

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: The use of Conforming DMD are permitted during the competition. Devices that have a slope must have the slope function turned OFF during play. Players that carry or use a non-conforming device will be disqualified.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Contestant's are expected to (1) know and play by the Rules of Golf, (2) conduct themselves at all times in a sportsmanlike manner, (3) respect the golf course and the rights of other contestants, (4) fulfill their playing obligations and (5) know and abide by the "Ready Golf" policy in regard to pace of play.

DRESS CODE: Suitable attire must be worn at all times and in accordance with AGC dress code policies.

CARTS AND CADDIES: Players may use carts or caddies for the Championship.

"SPECTATOR CARTS" WILL NOT BE ALLOWED: Only official carts authorized by the Tournament Committee will be allowed on the course. Players in violation are subject to penalty and/or disqualification. Spectator carts will be allowed only in the case of a playoff for Gross Champion in any division.
