

ARROWHEAD Women's
2026 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP
SATURDAY, August 22nd & SUNDAY, August 23rd

TOURNAMENT DATES: Saturday, August 22nd & Sunday, August 23rd, 2026

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to Women Amateur golfers who are members in good standing of Arrowhead Women's Golf Association, (18 years of age or older) as of August 21, 2026. Any entry without a 2026 USGA Handicap will be eligible for gross prizes only. (August 17th handicap revision will be used.)

FORMAT AND PRIZES: 36 Hole Stroke Play, Gross and Net merchandise prizes awarded to top finishers in all divisions. Divisions to be determined by number of entrants. Tees: Red Tees

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 entry fee

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entry forms must reach the AGC Office by 9:00 P.M. Tuesday, August 18th

RULES: USGA Rules of Golf will govern all play except for those conditions modified by Local rules which will be published prior to the start of the Championship. All questions will be resolved by the AWGA Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final.

TIES: In the event of a tie for the Gross Championship, the winner shall be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off.

GOLF EQUIPMENT: (14 Club Limit) The penalty for making a stroke with a non-conforming golf club is DISQUALIFICATION. The "One Ball Rule" SHALL NOT BE IN EFFECT!!

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: The use of Conforming DMD are permitted during the competition. Devices that measure anything other than distance are non-conforming. Any player that carries or uses a non-conforming device will be disqualified.

PROHIBITION OF OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Electronic devices can only be used for matters relating to the tournament (live scoring, rules questions) and for emergencies. Earbuds and music are also prohibited during play. Any violation of this rule will be followed by a verbal warning, a second violation will result in a penalty at the discretion of the tournament committee.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Contestant's are expected to (1) know and play by the Rules of Golf, (2) conduct themselves at all times in a sportsmanlike manner, (3) respect the golf course and the rights of other contestants, (4) fulfill their playing obligations and (5) know and abide by the "Ready Golf" policy in regards to pace of play.

DRESS CODE: Suitable attire must be worn at all times and according to AGC dress code published in Membership handbook.

SPIKELESS SHOES: Contestants in this competition WILL NOT be allowed to wear metal spikes or any shoe that could penetrate or damage a soft putting green.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION AND CADDIES: Players may use automotive transportation or caddies for the Championship.

"SPECTATOR CARTS" WILL NOT BE ALLOWED: Only official carts authorized by the Tournament Committee will be allowed on the course. Players in violation are subject to penalty and/or disqualification.
